2 MINUTES OF THE MEETING The minutes of the meeting held on the Monday, 10 June 2019, having been circulated with the agenda were agreed and then signed.

3 DECLARATION OF INTEREST: Councillor Thomas on planning applications 19/00263/APP, 19/00212/FUL and 19/00213/FUL

4 COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT: Reported as follows:

- Meeting with Craig Freeman from Glos Highways to go through the various Highways issues in Minsterworth
- GCC are keen to engage with 11-18 years olds

5 TEWKESBURY BOROUGH COUNCIL REPORT: Borough Councillor McLain's report was circulated to the Councillors prior to the meeting – the Chairman gave a short synopsis.

6 PUBLIC COMMENT (MAX 10 MINUTES) Comments received on how the drainage would be dealt with on Planning applications 19/00263/APP, 19/00212/FUL & 19/00213/FUL.

7 MATTERS ARISING:

7.1 Report from Village Hall Representative: Councillor Blowey thanked everyone involved in the fete which was very successful with approximately £4,000 being raised.

7.2 Minsterworth Park: Councillor Ingham reported as follows:

- Due to the current short-term lease with GCC no one will give a grant for any new equipment or provide a wider range of equipment for the children.
- She and the Chairman met with Adrian Goode on the 20 June to discuss the possible way forward. Another meeting the 18 July to discuss further.
- There was an issue with GCC and the adjoining boundaries -this has now been resolved satisfactorily.
- **7.3 Defibrillator:** Councillor Thomas reported provisional date for First Aid Training provisionally booked for Friday 6 September. Defibrillator still to be fixed.

7.4 Highway Matters:

Calcotts Green Sign still needs to be replaced

Chevron Signs still need to be repaired (by Chairman's house)

Bury Lane: In poor condition with some large potholes – criteria is 2" and dinner plate size in circumference.

Accident at The Dinney: A car left the road and has been reported to the police. The Minsterworth and Footpath signs need to be replaced and some reflective posts.

7.5 GCC PROW: EMW29: This has been cleared. EMW8 has also been cleared.

The Clerk said she had received an email from Suzanne Hope stating the previous funding she mentioned was still available ie GCC will fund 50% of the costs of new gates meaning the other 50%

needs to be met by landowners and/or contributions from elsewhere. Suzanne Hopes stated that hopefully GCC would be able to make use of the PCs offer to contribute £250 for the kissing gates at Cornham on another project. The Councillors said that any contribution would be considered on a case by case basis - Clerk to inform Suzanne Hopes.

7.6 Broadband: The Chairman reported that the Gigaclear meeting was very well attended – they are commencing works again along the Lower Road and an agreement had been reached regarding the medieval path. Further information regarding Broadband will be circulated by mail chimp so if any parishioners are not registered they could contact the Chairman or Clerk. Hopefully fibre broadband will go live around November time.
