There has been active involvement with planning issues and drainage, but not always getting the answers we need in a timely manner.

Highways have been an ongoing issue, particularly with speed past many new houses. Progress was felt to be made, with the initial meeting with our MP and several other CC officers.

Flooding has been addressed by the Borough Council and National Government with grants to help those affected. The Borough is aiming to be more proactive and supportive in the years to follow with climate change.
