FLOOD

This Past 12 months have been kinder to the village than in previous years, with no major flooding problems to report. Having said this Agricultural low lying ground suffered some flooding over the winter months, which saved the Village from severe flooding.

Properties which were flooded in the last major flooding are largely still being brought back into being habitable.

The river, weather & the river flood gauge have been regularly monitored when possible flooding is forecast. The main A.48 suffered periodic flooding, just outside the Village boundary at The Dinney, whilst the tide ran.

As Flood warden I attend as many updates & Flood briefings as I am able, reporting points of interest back via the Parish Council.

SNOW

The winter, despite having restocked our village supplies of salt etc we have been fortunate to only receive a few light coverings of snow. We have an allocated snow plough operator who is at the end of a 'phone should we deem it necessary.
