Our two Minsterworth Charities were established by two former Minsterworth residents, namely John Hiatt (d 1719) and Joseph Winkle (d 1723). The John Hiatt Charity was originally established to provide tools for children under 25 to improve their prospects for work, and is now available for anyone who wishes to undertake further training or education, in the widest sense of the wording. The Joseph Winkle charity originally provided a coal allowance for heating for the needy in the village, and is now available for anyone needing help for mobility etc.
