### Context

- Minsterworth has a long and proud history
- For decades, the village has evolved gradually
- Likely to see unprecedented change in coming years
- Mandatory targets to build 1.5m homes over 5 years
- Parish Council a statutory consultee for all planning
- A Village Design Statement could help to guide consistent, sympathetic, sustainable, long-term development

### What is a Village Design Statement?

- Compiled by residents with Parish Council support
- Describes Minsterworth and its valued characteristics
- Outlines residents' vision of what village should look like
- Lists guidance statements a 'roadmap' for the future
- Can influence planning strategy, applications & appeals
- Can provide guidance for developers & builders
- NOT about being 'NIMBY'

# What's in a VDS?

- Description, guidelines and recommendations on
  - History of village to present day
  - The natural environment
  - The built environment
  - Community & demographic data
  - Infrastructure
  - Commercial & business
- Submitted to County & Borough Councils
- No obligation to follow guidelines, but gives all residents a voice and a chance of being heard

# Why is a VDS needed?
