

Clerks report May 2025

Information

Work is being done on moving hosting over for the Clerk email by Cuttlefish and System force. I will send an email notification when the email address changes.

Community speed watch correspondence and quarterly report received on 1st May and sent to Parish Council.

Notification has been received to say that funding has been approved at the first stage for the 'Build back better' application towards the 20mph scheme.

A further application for funding for the 20mph scheme has been submitted to Gloucestershire Highways match funding.

As agreed at the April PC meeting a response has been submitted to GAPTC on the devolution survey completed by Cllr V King and The Clerk.

The meeting with Council representatives regarding flooding and community support is in the process of being arranged and the PC will be notified when a date is decided to confirm if you are able to attend.

The Chairman's board update has been completed and will be collected next week by the Clerk.

A response has been submitted on behalf of the PC as agreed to support the TRO for the proposed 50mph and 20mph speed limits in Minsterworth village.

Financial

The Quarterly check has been completed by Cllr V King to coincide with the end of financial year.

The Chair is in the process of requesting that the Clerk be added as the primary contact for the PC bank account. When this has been completed the Clerk can request that signatories are added to approve payments.

Correspondence

Some residents have emailed to say that the delay in grass cutting is making the village look untidy. One residents suggested that the tender process should have been carried out over the Winter.

A request has been received by a representative to request that the PC submit their legal contact details in order to grant the access request previously discussed over Calcotts green. The Clerk has contacted one legal to request advice.
